



- A firm delivery period must be indicated, **NOT LONGER THAN 7 WORKING DAYS AFTER ORDER.**
- For all transaction tax Clearance certificate must be attached.
- The service provider **MUST** complete the following MBDs form (4, 6.1 and 8) failure to complete those forms will led to disqualification.

- Copy of company registration reflecting equity owned by the members and status.
- ALL service providers should complete MBD6.1 form in order to claim points on special goals.
- All quotations will be evaluated in terms of preferential points system as prescribed in the preferential procurement policy regulation of 2022 as adopted by council on the 28 February 2023
- Only companies registered on the CSD will be considered.
- Municipal rates & taxes information in the bid document must be duly completed by Local Municipality or Landlord stamp or lease agreement with Landlord municipal rates and taxes or Affidavit with Landlord municipality rates and taxes.



Asset	Quantity	Description of asset	Motivation for need
Mobile test equipment	4	Mobile Water Turbidity Meter	Turbidity meters are needed for EHPs to measure turbidity (or cloudiness) of water caused by suspended solid particles for compliance purposes. This is used to ensure the effectiveness of disinfection and good operation of the distribution system
	4	Digital Chlorometers	The instrument is used to provide rapid analysis of chlorine for field operatives validating the safety of water. The instrument will detect the process of water disinfection. The instrument will be used by EHP's.
	10	Laser thermometer	Instrument needed to test temperatures at food premises for food and cooling facilities. Temperature control plays a major role in food handling especially now that we facing load shedding episodes and most facilities do not have automatic backup system.
